

ACT Exam Information

- **What?**
 - A nationally recognized exam that colleges and universities use as part of their admissions process
- **Why?**
 - A requirement to graduate from Clark County School District and supportive of CCSD's College and Career Readiness initiative—simply completing the test meets graduation requirements
- **When?**
 - February 27, 2018 / 7:45 a.m. to approximately 1:00 p.m.—be on time!
- **Who?**
 - All 11th grade students and those 12th graders that did not complete the test last year
- **Where?**
 - West Prep

- **Do this:**
 - Take the exam seriously and do your best
 - Continue to prepare with the support from your Junior Studies class
 - Get a good night's sleep the night before the exam
 - Be on time to the test! Late arrivals WILL NOT be allowed to participate

- **Do NOT Do this:**
 - Do not bring backpacks or any other materials
 - Do not be late!
 - Do not skip questions on the test—there is no penalty for guessing

- **General Info**
 - *Cell phones will be collected and kept secure by school personnel. This will safeguard against an incident that might invalidate a student's test and require them to make it up*
 - Calculators will be provided for students. If students choose to bring their own, it must meet specific requirements (see link). [We recommend using the school's calculator]
 - All other test material, including pencils, will be provided
 - Water and snacks will be provided at break time. You may bring your own drinks and snacks but will not be allowed access to them except during break time
 - Lunch will be provided by the cafeteria at the normal high school lunch time
 - When students are done the test, or with lunch, they will have the option of leaving for the day. Students that choose to leave must leave campus.
 - Those students that need to stay for the bus, after school programs, siblings, or for any other reason, will be provided an educational opportunity until 3:30 p.m.
